

Tautai Trust Artist Residency 2017

Criteria for Selection

The Tautai Trust Residency is available to a contemporary artist who fulfils the following criteria:

- * A person of Pacific Island heritage, residing outside of New Zealand.
- * A contemporary artist who is committed to a career as a professional artist
- * An artist who has executed sufficient work to indicate that they are possessed of sufficient talent
- * Supplies a written statement explaining why they wish to be selected for the artist residency program
- * Supplies at least two references or statements of endorsement for their application
- * A person prepared to engage with the Tautai community of artists and supporters
- * Is of good character and health and wellbeing and must be aged 25 years or over
- * Can confirm that they will be available to take up the residency during February/ March 2017
- * Applications must be received by Tautai prior to **28 October 2016**

Selection of the artist for the Tautai Trust Artist Residency will be made by a panel appointed by the Trust and the successful applicant will be notified by the beginning of December 2016. The decision of the panel will be final.
